Please try and pack lightly – we are only away for two nights!

Bedding: St. George's House provide you with a bottom sheet, pillow, pillow case and duvet with a cover. This cover is only an undercover so you need to bring either of the following but **NOT BOTH**:

*1. Single size duvet cover **OR** 2. Sleeping bag.*

Clothing: A suitable coat, a couple of WARM jumpers etc, it can get quite cold! A good quality pair of shoes or trainers, Nightwear, Socks, Day Wear, Underwear (!!), Swimwear, your sunshine shoes and slippers. Please pay attention to the weather forecasts and pack accordingly – it can be freezing cold, boiling hot or very wet!

Miscellaneous: A small torch, a plastic bag for dirty washing, a small personal MP3 Player may be brought for private listening but no large sound systems please, camera. There is a pool and football table which eats 10p's and 20p's.

CONDUCT CONTRACT [You COMPLETE & RETURN this]

We want our activities to be an enjoyable experience for all those attending. We ask each young person and their Parent(s)/Carer(s) to read through this agreement so everyone understands what is expected and what happens if there are any problems. This will ensure we all have a great time and it is an important part of the Church's Child Protection and Health and Safety Policies. Thank you.

Agreement:

- I will not bring or consume any alcohol, drugs (other than prescribed medicines) or cigarettes during the weekend.
- I will treat the Leaders and other Young People as I would want to be treated. I will not use rude or offensive language and will show respect to all the Leaders and St. George's House Staff who are there for my safety and protection.
- I will treat other people's property with respect.
- I will allow other people to sleep at night.
- I understand that if I break this agreement my behaviour will be confronted once. This constitutes a warning (issued by one of the Senior Leaders: James Hennah or Sue Hall). If I persist then one or more of the sanctions below will be applied. Where there is a serious breach of the agreement (eg drugs/alcohol use) then no warning will be given and sanctions will be directly applied.

Sanctions:

- I will miss one or more of the activities and/or I will be assigned domestic duties e.g. washing up.
- [During the night] I will be moved to another dormitory & supervised by Leaders.
- My Parent(s)/Carer(s) will be contacted and advised of my behaviour and/or on my return a letter will be sent home.
- For persistent or serious breaches of the agreement, my Parent(s)/Carer(s) will be contacted and they will be expected to come and take me home.
